

Lifetime Reading List in Chronological Order

Part 3: 1700-1899

Again, poets and philosophers receive scant attention during this period, since (as mentioned) I am mostly interested in narrative. Unlisted English authors that might interest some readers include Thomas Gray (“Elegy Written in a Country Churchyard”), Elizabeth Barrett Browning, John Greenleaf Whittier, Dante Gabriel Rossetti, and Algernon Charles Swinburne. Nor will one find works by scientists or philosophers such as Giambattista Vico. As for English and American poets, I recommend you read a good anthology, such as *The Norton Anthology of Poetry* and *The Oxford Book of American Verse*. For Italian poets not included below, one might read the 18th century poets Pietro Metastasio, Giuseppe Parini, and Vittorio Alfieri (listed below for his plays), and the 19th century poet Ugo Foscolo (listed below for his fiction). For French poets, see Alphonse de Lamartine, Alfred de Vigny, Aloysius Bertrand, Alfred de Musset, Stéphane Mallarmé, and Paul Verlaine. For Spanish poets: Gustavo Adolfo Bécquer, among others. For German poets: Novalis, Hölderlin, and Heinrich Heine. Playwrights as famous as Pierre Corneille (*The Cid*), and Jean Racine (*Phaedra*, *Andromache*) are not listed below, nor are German writers such as Friedrich Schiller (*Mary Stuart*, *Don Carlos*) and Gotthold Lessing (*Laocoön*, *Nathan the Wise*). English essayists are also in short supply, for which one might cite: William Hazlitt, Charles Lamb, Thomas Carlyle, John Ruskin, and Walter Pater.
