

Lifetime Reading List in Chronological Order

Part 5: 1961-1975

A few authors of popular fiction who have been very prolific are listed only once or twice (unless there are compelling reasons to add other titles) under the assumption that a reader who enjoys their work will find other books on their own. These authors include Edward S. Aarons, Desmond Bagley, Lawrence Sanders, Agatha Christie, Dick Francis, Sue Grafton, Zane Grey, Jack Higgins (Harry Patterson), Patricia Highsmith, Hammond Innes, Helen MacInnes, Alistair MacLean, Ed McBain, Robert B. Parker, Georges Simenon, and Ross Thomas. From this point on most (but not all) of the works listed are fiction. From Part 5 on, this list favors novels of suspense, although I have tried to include a sampling of so-called serious literary fiction and a representative selection of works in other forms of popular fiction, e.g., horror, sci-fi, romance, fantasy, teen lit., and so forth. Still, the list is not balanced from that point on.
